- 1. The Liberal Arts Emphasis in Social Sciences is designed to acquaint students with the diversity of subjects in the Social Sciences. The Social Sciences offer a broad study in human behavior. This area of emphasis will be an ideal choice for students planning to transfer to the California State University or University of California educational institutions. Students can satisfy their general education requirements, plus focus on transferable coursework that relates to majors in liberal arts or liberal studies at CSU or UC campuses. Each student should consult with a counselor for specific information regarding intended majors at the specific college/university of choice.
- 2. No more than 6 units from each discipline
- 3. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
- 4. The Associate Degree requires completion of the major (18 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course. Students must complete one of the three different general education patterns: option 1 Fresno City College General Education, option 2 CSU GE– California State University General Education, OR option 3 IGETC Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
