**Notes:**

1. The Pre-Allied Health degree offers an interdisciplinary approach of study for students seeking to enter the profession of health care in a variety of ways. The degree will allow students to pursue a rigorous course of study before selecting in an area of concentration to match their career and study interests. With emphasis on basic science, cultural competence in healthcare, the degree offered will prepare students to pursue Allied Health and Nursing programs.
2. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
3. The *Associate Degree* requires completion of the major (24-27 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course. Students must complete one of the three different general education patterns: option 1 – Fresno City College General Education, option 2 – CSU GE Breadth– California State University General Education, OR option 3 – IGETC – Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum for a total of **60 semester units minimum** with a 2.0 or better GPA.
4. Some of the courses are program prerequisites for Allied Health and Nursing Programs at Fresno City College.
5. It is recommended that students complete AHLTH 100 during their first semester.
