## Notes:

- Students should avoid accumulating additional journalism units as they complete their AA-T degree (which
  requires 60 units). Additional units will create graduation problems at the upper division. Many programs require
  80 units outside of journalism for the degree and each CSU may require up to 28 upper division units in the major.
- 2. Some of the above courses may have prerequisites. See the catalog or schedule of classes.
- 3. The Associate Degree for Transfer requires completion of the major (18-19 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Education requirements (either CSU GE Breadth or IGETC CSU) for a total of 60 CSU-transferable semester units minimum with a 2.0 or better GPA.
