- 1. An Associate in Arts in Social Work and Human Services for Transfer degree, is designed for students who plan to complete a Bachelor's degree in a similar major at a CSU campus. The degree will acquaint students with the fundamentals of the human services system and the profession of Social Work, including introduction to the theories, principles, and values on which human services are offered and social work is practiced in the United States
- The Associate Degree for Transfer requires completion of the major (29-34 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course plus the completion of the General Education requirements (either CSU GE Breadth or IGETC CSU) for a total of 60 CSU-transferable semester units minimum with a 2.0 or better GPA.
