- 1. This Certificate of Achievement is designed to prepare students to work with infants, toddlers and young children with disabilities and other special needs in early intervention settings and inclusive early care and education settings. A student who completes the certificate, is qualified to work at the Early Intervention Assistant I level of the California Early Start Personnel Model.
- Completing the Early Intervention Assistant Certificate plus the Associate Degree in Child Development qualifies a
 student to work at the Early Intervention Assistant II level of the California Early Start Personnel Model. The Early
 Intervention Assistant certificate units apply to the Associate Degree in Child Development. To graduate with the
 Associate Degree in Child Development student must take CHDEV 37A in addition to the Early Intervention
 Assistant certificate.
- 3. CHDEV 1 is not required for the Early Intervention certificate but is a prerequisite to CHDEV 20.
- 4. The Certificate of Achievement requires completion of the major (30 units) with a "C" or better grade in each course.
